Who we are:

Anchorage re:MADE provides economic empowerment for people. The entrepreneurs learn how to repurpose, repaint, repair and how to sell retail. We currently are fundraising to purchase the 17,000 sq. foot building that we are in which includes retail space, training rooms, two offices, woodshop, café coffee bar and a commercial kitchen. Each of these entrepreneurs volunteer from four to forty hours a week producing items to sell (and earning income). Our team is 100% volunteer, self-funded or grant contract labor.

We rescue usable goods from the landfill every Tuesday & Saturday. What is unique about Anchorage re:MADE is that because we have a retail store, we have a market to sell the usable products rescued. In this process we not only change the environment, but also utilize the opportunity to empower people to create a job for themselves. This has become a way to create small businesses, that impact the economy in Anchorage. By giving people a hand-up rather than a hand-out, it helps them take small steps to change their situation. Those making minimum wage at their job, receiving social security, disability, have unexpected expenses, unable to work a conventional job, or have hit a rough spot financially can supplement their income by repurposing items to make a living wage.



So much of what we know is caught rather than taught. People from all socioeconomic groups work alongside each other repurposing, they learn and “catch” behaviors, attitudes of how to work effectively, efficiently and how to see work.

We offer classes: drawing, watercolor painting, chair and sign painting, how to repurpose clothing, knitting, cooking classes, goal setting, life mapping, excel, and many others. We love to see people changing habits from consuming to repurposing, reselling while renewing lives as we are Doing Life. Better Together.
